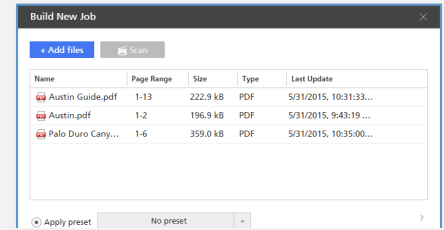
1 JOB MERGE

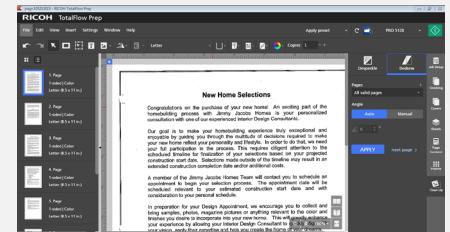
2 IMAGE OF SCANNED DOCUMENT

- Improved productivity by automating the process



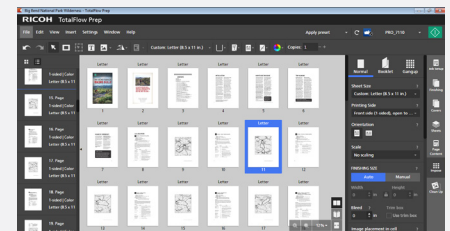
3 PAGE ORDER CHANGE

- Disruptive redos and errors can be avoided



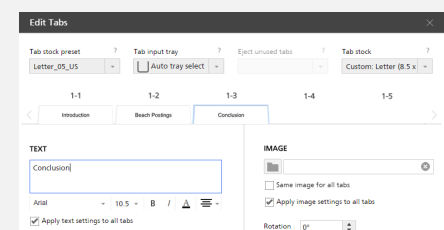
4 TAB SETTINGS

- Productivity is dramatically enhanced



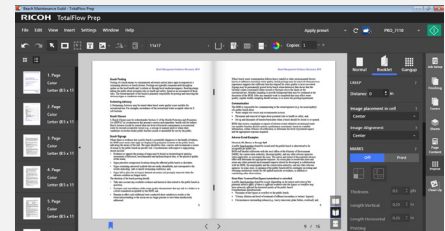
5 IMPOSITION

- Reduces errors and improves productivity



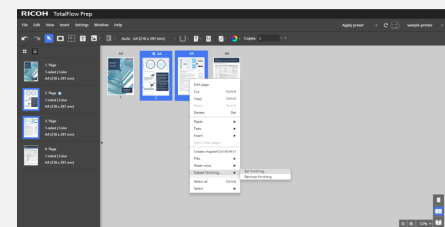
6 SUBSET STAPLING

- Eliminates the need for post production hand collation.



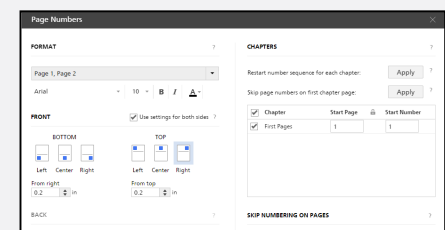
7 PAGE NUMBERING

- The page numbering function prevents mistakes when re-numbering a document



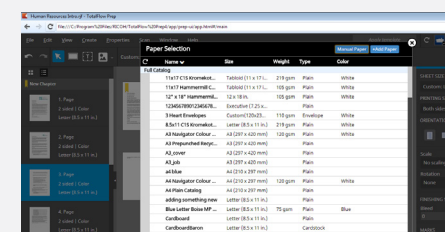
8 MEDIA SETTING

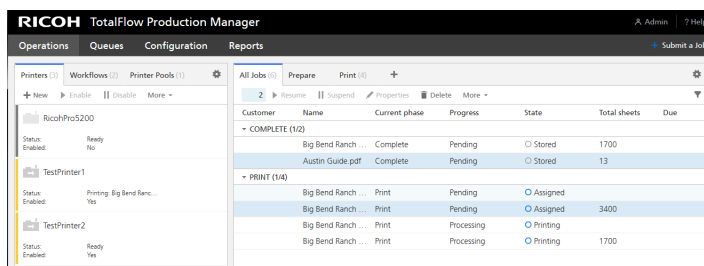

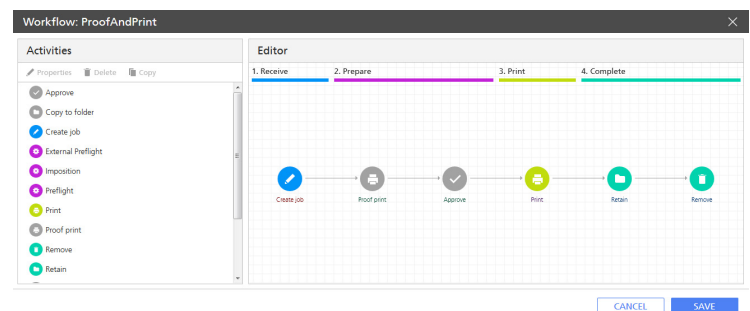
